

HORIZON EUROPE STRATEGIC PLAN 2021-2024

- Defines 4 Key Strategic Orientations
 - Cluster 6 should contribute mainly to 2 of them: "Restoring Europe's ecosystems and biodiversity, and managing sustainably natural resources to ensure food security and a clean and healthy environment" and "Making Europe the first digitally enabled circular, climate-neutral and sustainable economy"



CLUSTER 6 WORK PROGRAMME FOR 2023-2024

- Publication probably on 28 November 2022
- Opening of the calls probably in December 2022
- Separate calls for each destination
- Both one and two stage evaluation procedure
- Type of Instruments:
 - Research and Innovation Actions
 - Innovation Actions
 - Coordination and Support Actions
 - Cofund
- In some (82 out of 176) topics specific requirements for multi-actor approach
- In some (56, mainly CSAs) topics lump sum funding
- In some (52) international cooperation encouraged
- In some (25) topics blind evaluation pilot (1st stage of 2-stages calls)





- Understand and address direct drivers of biodiversity decline
- Plan, manage and expand protected areas
- Mainstream biodiversity, ecosystem services and natural capital in the society and economy
- Develop and improve practices in agriculture, forestry, fisheries and aquaculture
- Interconnect biodiversity research and support policies and processes

2023:

- 1 stage evaluation call
- budget: 184 mil. €; deadline: 28 March 2023
- 18 topics (12 RIA, 2 IA, 3 CSA, 1 Cofund), examples:
- impacts of chemical / light and noise pollution on biodiversity; assessment of changes affecting terrestrial and freshwater ecosystems; conservation status of EU-protected species and habitats; reducing bycatch of protected species; biodiversity and nature-based solutions in higher education; biodiversity, economics and finance; biodiversity in urban areas; reinforcing science policy support with IPBES and IPCC; crop wild relatives for sust. agriculture; integrative forest management; legume crops; zoonotic diseases

2023:

- 1 stage evaluation call
- budget: 196,5 mil. €; deadline: 12 April 2023
- 20 topics (8 RIA, 4 IA, 5 CSA, 3 Cofund), examples:
- African swine fever vaccine; alternatives to reduce the use of pesticides; artificial intelligence to fight illegal fish discards; eradication of micronutrient deficiencies; new detection methods of GMOs; cultured meat and seafood; prevention and reduction of food waste; resilient European food systems; microbiomes in food processing, packaging and shelf life; EU African Union cooperation in food and agriculture


- climate-neutrality, zero pollution, fair and just circular and bioeconomy transitions
- safe, integrated circular solutions at territorial and sectoral levels
- key bioeconomy sectors such sustainable bio-based systems, forestry, small-scale rural bio-based solutions, environmental services and aquatic value chains

2023:

- 1 and 2 stage evaulation calls
- Budget: 98,5 + 80 mil. €; deadline: 28 March 2023 (2 stage: 26 September 2023)
- 17 topics (7 RIA, 5 IA, 5 CSA), examples:
- ricular model households; market uptake of circular water related projects; land-based bioprospecting and production of bioactive compounds and functional materials; bio-based solutions in humanitarian aid; low-toxicity/zero pollution construction bio-based materials; business models in bioeconomy; aquatic organisms for blue biotechnology; small-scale forest management for wood/non-wood products; tailor-made forest services; Circular Cities and Regions Initiative systemic solutions; bio-based textiles; non-plant biomass feedstock for industrial applications

- Enhancing circular bio-based systems



2023:

- 1 and 2 stage evaulation calls
- budget: 64,5 + 15 mil. €; deadline: 28 March 2023 (2 stage: 26 September 2023)
- 9 topics (8 RIA, 1 IA), examples:
- > solutions in agriculture for water availability and quality; emerging pollutants; pollution in the Arctic; improved sustainability of industrial bio-based processes; biosensors and diagnostic tools for environmental services; prevention/reduction of plastic packaging pollution from the food system; optimisation of manure use; bio-based solutions as alternatives for chemicals, materials, products

- climate change mitigation in the primary sectors
- sustainable management of scarce resources

2023:

- 1 stage call
- budget: 90 mil. €; deadline: 12 April 2023
- 8 topic (4 RIA, 2 IA, 1 CSA, 1 Cofund), examples:
- ➤ alternative water resources supply systems and technologies; demonstration network on climatesmart farming; pilot network of climate-positive organic farms; analysing fossil-energy dependence in agriculture; renewable energy at farm-level; Essential Ocean Variables in support of global assessments

- > social inclusion in rural areas; integrated territorial development in rural areas; benchmarking of rural and territorial policies; system of geographical indications; assessing urban farming impacts; sustainability food labelling

- 1 stage call
- budget: 130 mil. €; deadline: 23 March 2023
- 22 topics (11 RIA, 10 CSA, 1 Cofund), examples:
- ➤ analytical capacity and tools to support EU agri-food policies; pan-European academic network for food system science; bio-based business models for local communities; assessment of land use and biomass demands; BIOEAST networks development of national bioeconomy action programmes; EuroGEO initiative coordination; observation gaps in the land-sea interface; citizen engagement in envi protection





- Innovative governance, environmental observations and digital solutions in support of the Green Deal.




