

PROPOSAL CHECK EVENT



On 19 January 2023, Net4Society is offering an event focused on the assurance and improvement of the quality of project proposals submitted for the 2023 Cluster 2 calls. The aim of this Proposal Check Event is to increase the chances for funding and to transfer useful knowledge to project proposers. As a proposer, you will have the unique opportunity to discuss your proposals with experienced evaluators and National Contact Points to gain feedback on work already done.

Procedure

Interested coordinators present their proposal draft at early or more advanced stage of preparation for Cluster 2 2023 calls and receive qualified feedback from experienced evaluators immediately during the session. A dedicated counselling session consists of the evaluators reading the proposal, the proposers briefly presenting their project, and ensuing feedback round. There will also be the possibility for receiving additional consulting by experienced NCP staff. To ensure confidentiality, all participating experts will be asked to sign a non-disclosure agreement.

Who can attend?

The event will support proposals for Horizon Europe's Cluster 2 Calls 2023. Admission is open to the coordinator (i.e. one person, mandatory), plus one representative from a project partner institution (i.e. one optional person). In exceptional cases, the coordinator may name a proxy to attend in his or her place.

Please note that the evaluators will not check to determine that proposals reviewed correspond to the specific call for which the proposal is written. Therefore, it is strongly recommended that proposers have an abstract of their proposal checked by the corresponding NCP.

Application

Applications must be submitted via the online registration platform by the project coordinators, who must also denote the second participant for the event. The submission of applications will be open until **9 January 2023**.

Selection of participants

To select final event participants, applications will be fed into a quality assurance process. From there, selected proposers will be contacted prior to the event (no later than 12 January 2023) to assess the degree of completion of their proposals. Short-listed candidates will be invited based on the number of places available.

Participation in the event is free of charge.

In addition to this event, we also encourage you to attend the international Cluster 2 Brokerage Event, which will take place on the day before the Proposal Check Event, on 18 January 2023.
