### SECTORIAL PRIORITIES IN THE AREA OF RESEARCH

- Synergies in the research and innovation funding
- European research infrastructure ecosystem
- New European innovation agenda
- Single Basic Act (Joint Undertakings)
- International cooperation / Association agreements



## Synergies in the Research and Innovation Funding in Europe

- Synergies between national/regional and European research and innovation funding instruments, including the Horizon Europe EU Framework Programme for Research and Innovation, EU Cohesion Policy Funds, Recovery and Resilience Facility, Digital Europe Programme, InvestEU Fund, etc., as a key tool to increase the research and innovation funding intensity in Europe and exploit the full potential of the science and technology cooperation in the EU
- Organisation of a flagship conference Synergies in the Research and Innovation Funding in Europe
   7<sup>th</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> July 2022 in Prague to share experience, and exchange good practices and lessons learned,
   identify bottlenecks preventing from harvesting the full potential of synergies
- Call for action by the Prague Declaration to reinforce the commitments by the European Commission and Member States to continue removing barriers on synergies, and endorsement of the EU Council

## **COUNCIL CONCLUSIONS ON SYNERGIES**

- Special Report by the European Court of Auditors (ECA) No 23/2022 "Synergies between Horizon 2020 and European Structural and Investment Funds – Not yet used to full potential"
- Presented by ECA at the session of the Research Working Group of the Council of the EU (RWG) on 12th December 2022 at the end of the CZ PRES mandate

#### Council Conclusions

- To be adopted within three months since the publication of the ECA's special report
- First draft prepared by CZ PRES and examined by RWG on 12th December 2022
- Final draft approved by Education, Youth, Culture and Sport Council (Education) by SE PRES on 7th March 2023

## PRAGUE DECLARATION ON SYNERGIES IN THE R&I FUNDING IN EUROPE

#### Policy Framework

- Council Conclusions of 1st December 2020 welcome the new efforts for creating and exploiting synergies to maximise the impact of different sources of funding to ensure an effective twin transition and a quick recovery
- Regulation (EU) 2021/695 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 28th April 2021 elaborates on synergies, with the Annex IV. underlining specific directly managed EU programmes, where synergies shall be sought and put into practice
- Regulation (EU) 2021/1060 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 24th June 2021 emphasises the synergies and complementarities as instruments to optimise the added value from the EU and Member State investments
- Commission Regulation (EU) 2021/1237 of 23rd July 2021 amends the General Block Exemption Regulation and brings simplification in funding of projects awarded the Seal of Excellence label and the projects under the Teaming and European Partnerships
- Council Recommendation of 26th November 2021 highlights the importance of further strengthening synergies to increase access to excellence and R&I investments to foster the European Research Area
- Commission Notice of 5th July 2022 on Synergies between Horizon Europe and ERDF programmes provides with guidelines on synergies for the current EU programming period 2021–2027

## PRAGUE DECLARATION ON SYNERGIES IN THE R&I FUNDING IN EUROPE

#### CROSS-CUTTING OBJECTIVES AT THE EU LEVEL

- Reinforce dialogue with relevant stakeholders to enhance capacity building for synergies and take up the working methods of the Seal of Excellence Community of Practice, as a good practice example
- Publish the guidelines for the application of synergies, including information on practical use of synergies, thus giving directions on how to best take advantage of synergies
- Advance internal coordination and cooperation in the Commission to align implementation of the directly managed EU programmes and to better orchestrate the timing of the calls to submit project proposals under different EU programmes

#### CROSS-CUTTING OBJECTIVES AT THE MEMBER STATES LEVEL

- Enhance synergies between regional and national R&I funding instruments on one hand and the European ones on the other, including beyond the scope of the EU Cohesion Policy Funds
- Implement the Seal of Excellence scheme to finance the project proposals, which were assessed under a
  directly managed EU programme, received this quality label by duly complying with the quality
  requirements, but which could not be funded due to the budgetary constraints

## PRAGUE DECLARATION ON SYNERGIES IN THE R&I FUNDING IN EUROPE

#### Specific Goal in the Area of Research Infrastructures

• Take advantage of various EU, national and regional funding instruments to finance in synergy research infrastructures throughout their entire life-cycle period, depending on their current life-cycle phase

#### Specific Goal in the Area of European Partnerships and EU Missions.

 Align national and regional efforts with incentives implemented through the European Partnerships and EU Missions to bring together the critical mass of resources that are necessary to address grand societal challenges

#### Specific Goal in the Area of Innovation

 Cooperate with third parties, who are motivated to provide additional resources or services to the EIC holders and the EIC Seal of Excellence holders, including helping the "Seal of Excellence" holders cover their investment component

#### Specific Goal in the Area of the EU Cohesion Policy Funds

 Embrace synergies between the EU Cohesion Policy instruments and other EU, national and regional programmes throughout the phases of their design, creation and implementation, including the financial and administrative levels
