

THE BENEFITS OF PROJECT LEADERSHIP


- prestige that the coordinating body naturally gains
- ideal tool to promote own research and ideas

"The coordinator as captain can steer the research ship in a direction that makes sense and can more easily pursue own research directions and visions."

- economic dimension coordinators receive a third (and sometimes more) of the total project budget
- coordinators increase their country's participation in the FPs pull effect of coordinator the coordinator attracts more national participants to the project (research consortium), more coordinators means higher participations in FPs




COORDINATORS VS TOTAL PARTICIPATION






SHARE OF EU CONTRIBUTION IN CLUSTERS AND PRIORITIES OF HE – EU-13, PT, EL





SHARE OF EU CONTRIB. FOR COORDINATORS VS SII



SIGNIFICANCE OF PROJECT COORDINATION FOR THE PARTICIPATION OF THE CR IN THE FPS IS INCREASING


- Czech coordinators play key role in participation in HE share of Czech coordinators in the national financial contribution received from the FPs is increasing, significantly over the time –
- share of financial contribution for Czech coordinators is comparable with innovation leaders and strong innovators. The Czech Republic differs significantly from the majority "widening" countries
- Czech research teams and individual researchers are more and more often becoming leaders in HE projects. In particular, the share of financial contribution requested by Czech coordinators for projects with higher research and innovation ambitions (RIA, IA projects) is rising.
- While in FP7 Czech institutions coordinated only 10 collaborative CP projects (predecessor of the RIA/IA project type), in the H2020 programme 21 RIA and IA projects, in the first third the Czech Republic coordinates already 22 RIA/IA projects
- Leadership of projects with Czech coordinators is not based on coordination of widening projects or individual grants only



PROJECT COORDINATION POSSIBLE REASONS FOR IMPROVEMENT

- experience gained by project coordinators from previous FPs
- improved connections to national and foreign consulting firms and advisory services
- assistance vouchers for the preparation of project proposals
- consulting services of TC Praha, including the evaluation of project proposals in draft form or pre-screening of project proposals
- National Expert Group workshops for ERC applicants, including a sophisticated "mock interview" system for the preparation of ERC grants
- UK, CH impossibility to coordinate FP projects in the period 2021 2023
- successive elimination of myths about the inaccessibility and difficulty of FP projects




