

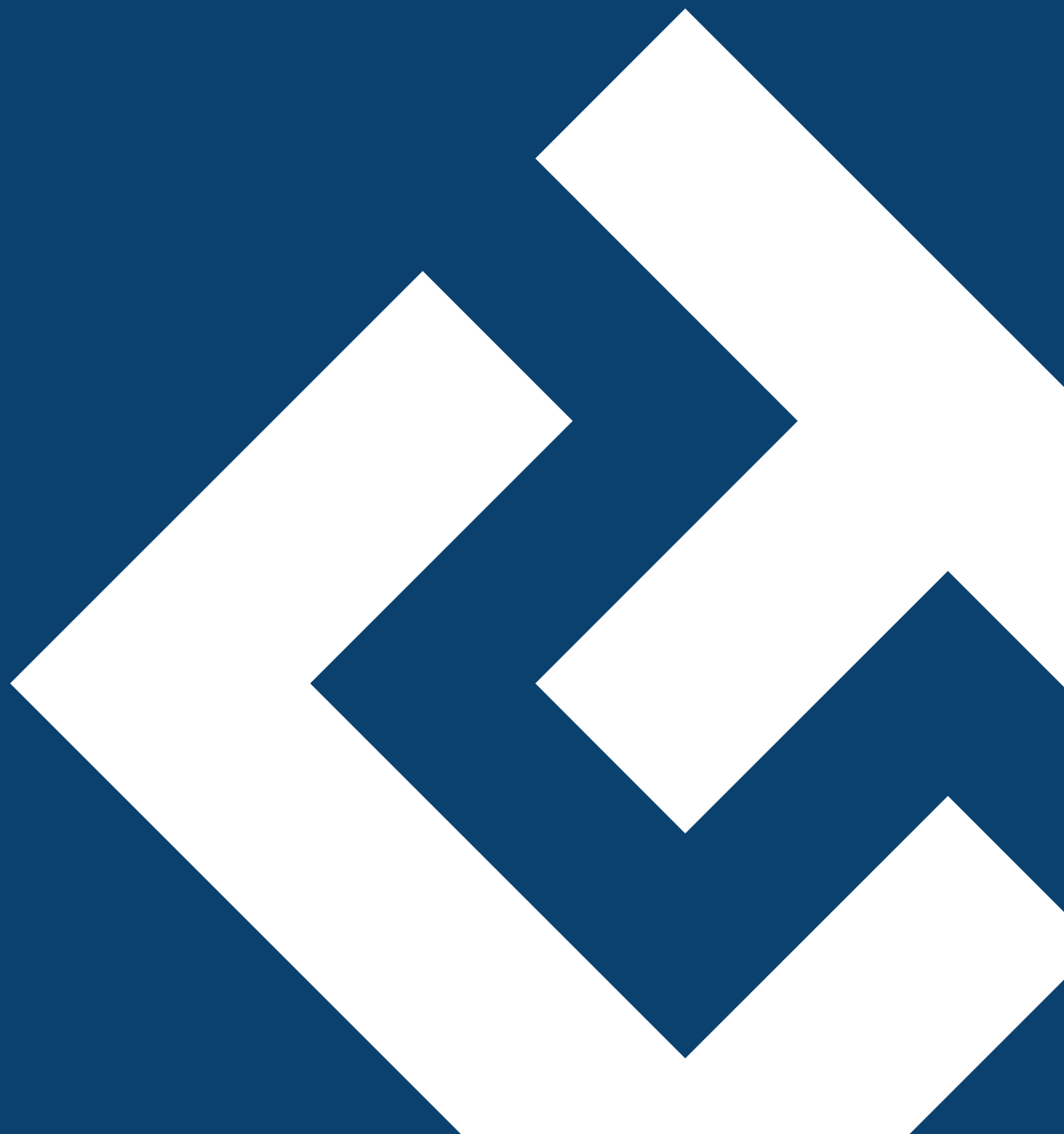

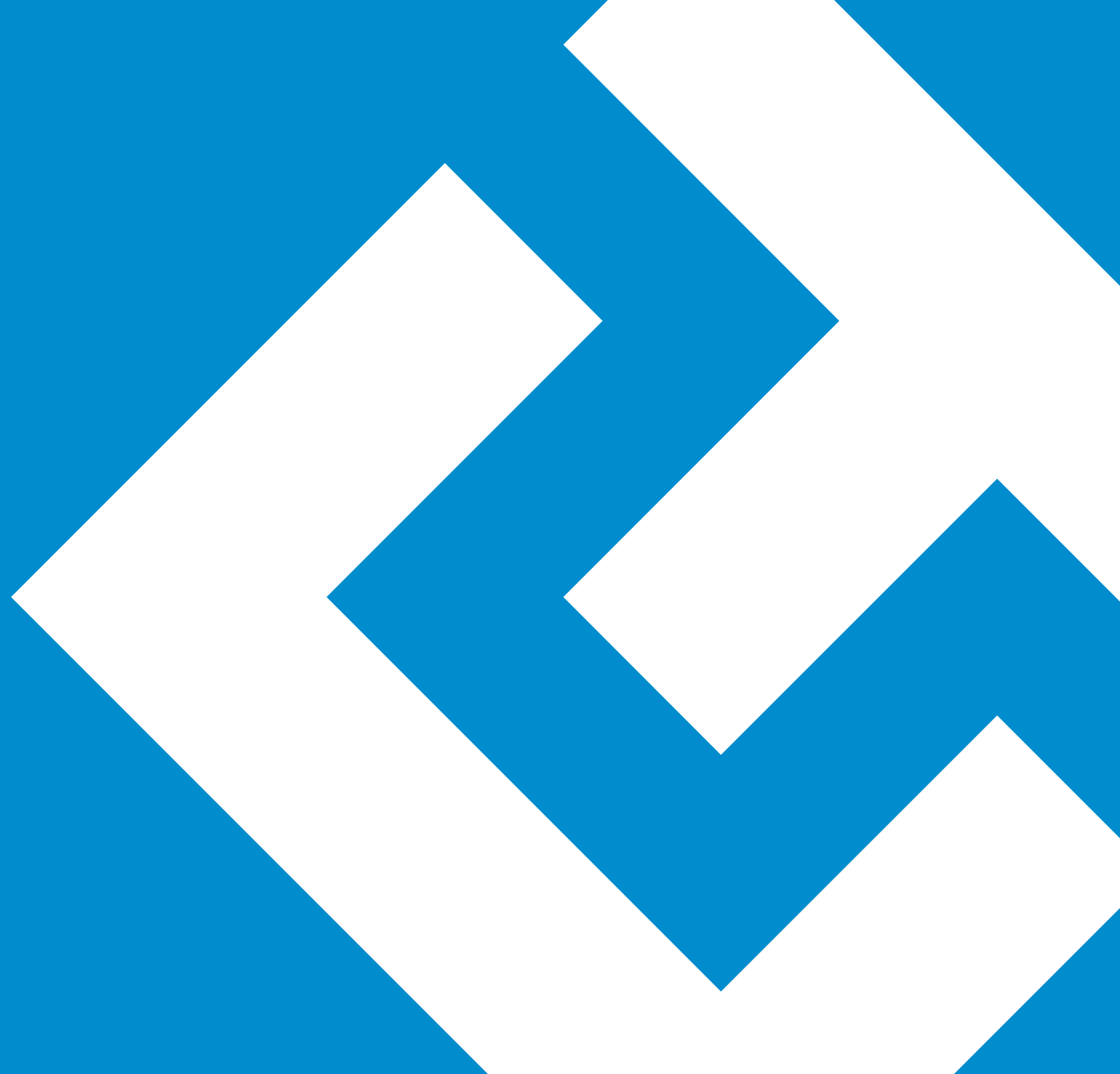

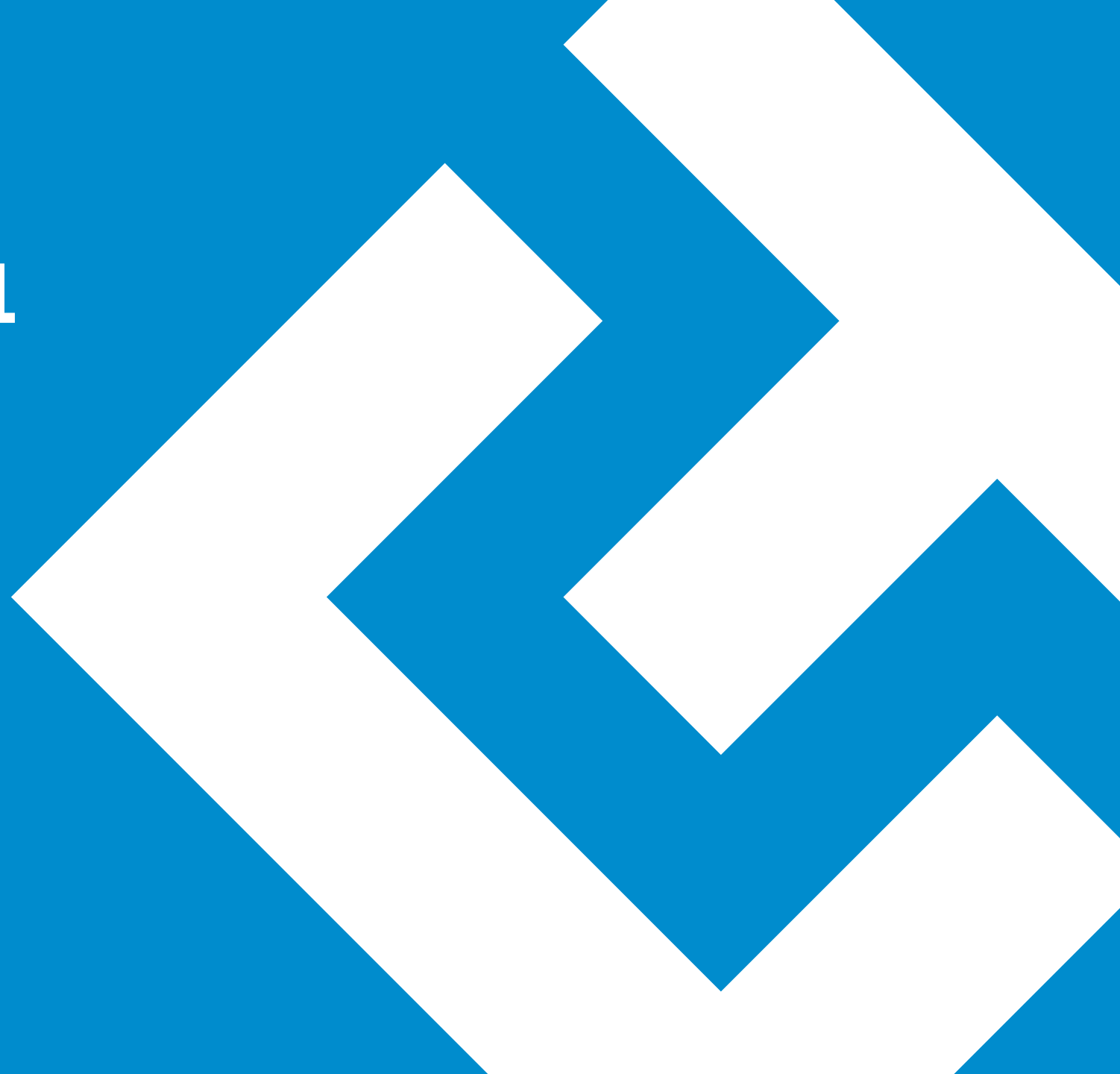


OVERVIEW

- HORIZON-WIDERA-2023-ACCESS-01-01
- Opening: 10 January 2023
- Deadline 1st stage: **12 April 2023**
- Deadline 2nd stage: **7 March 2024**
- Overall indicative budget: M€ 174
- Budget per project: M€ 8 – 15
- Project duration: up to 6 years
- Consortium: minimum 1 + 1
- Expected no. of projects: 18



TEAMING STAGE 1



SCORING

- The threshold for both criteria is 4.
- The overall threshold (applying to the sum of the two individual scores) will be set for the call at a level that allowed the total requested budget of proposals admitted to stage 2 be **as close as possible to 3 times the available budget (and not below 2.5 times the budget)**:
 - HORIZON-WIDERA-2023-ACCESS-01-01-two-stage Teaming for Excellence (Stage 1): **8.5 points**

GENERALISED FEEDBACK AFTER STAGE 1

- In order to best ensure equal treatment, successful stage 1 applicants **do not receive the evaluation summary reports (ESRs)** for their proposals, but this generalised feedback with information and tips for preparing the full proposal.

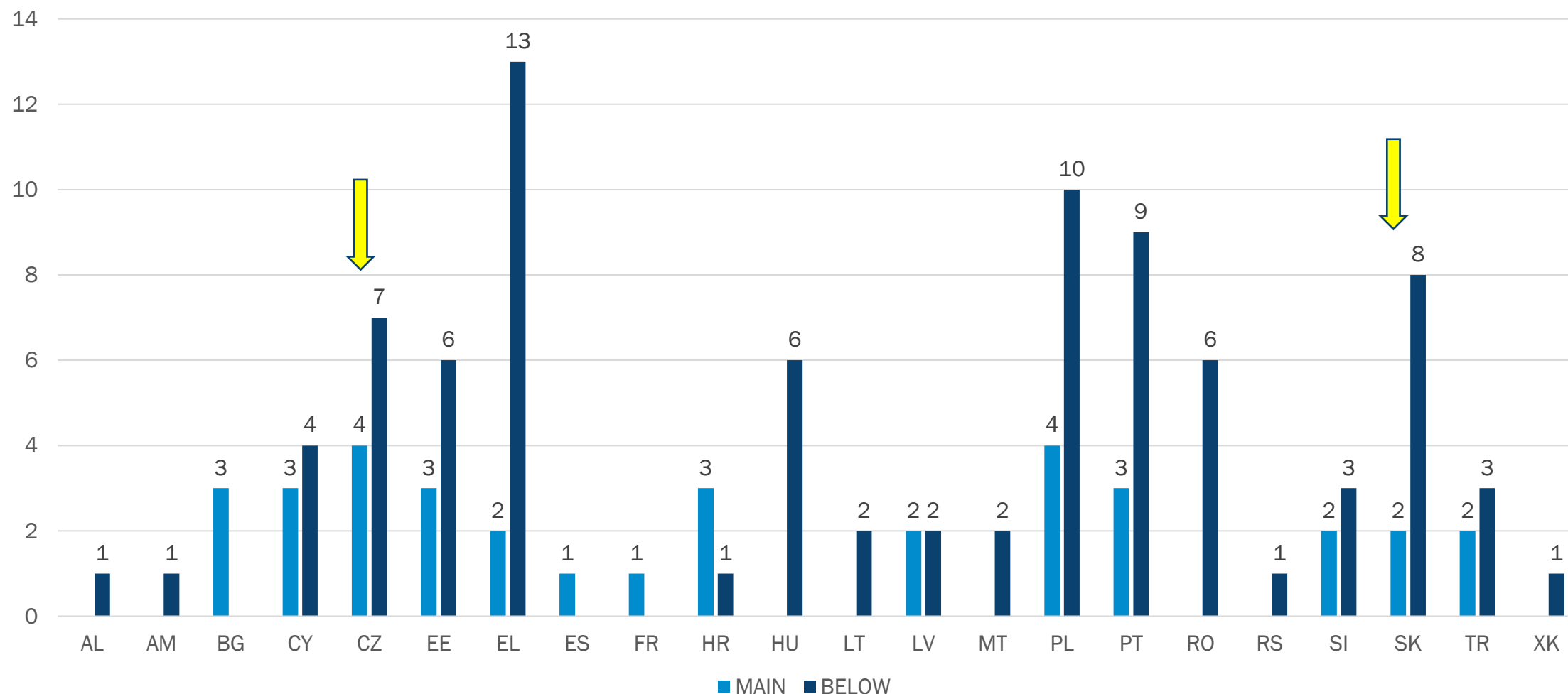

- Below threshold 88

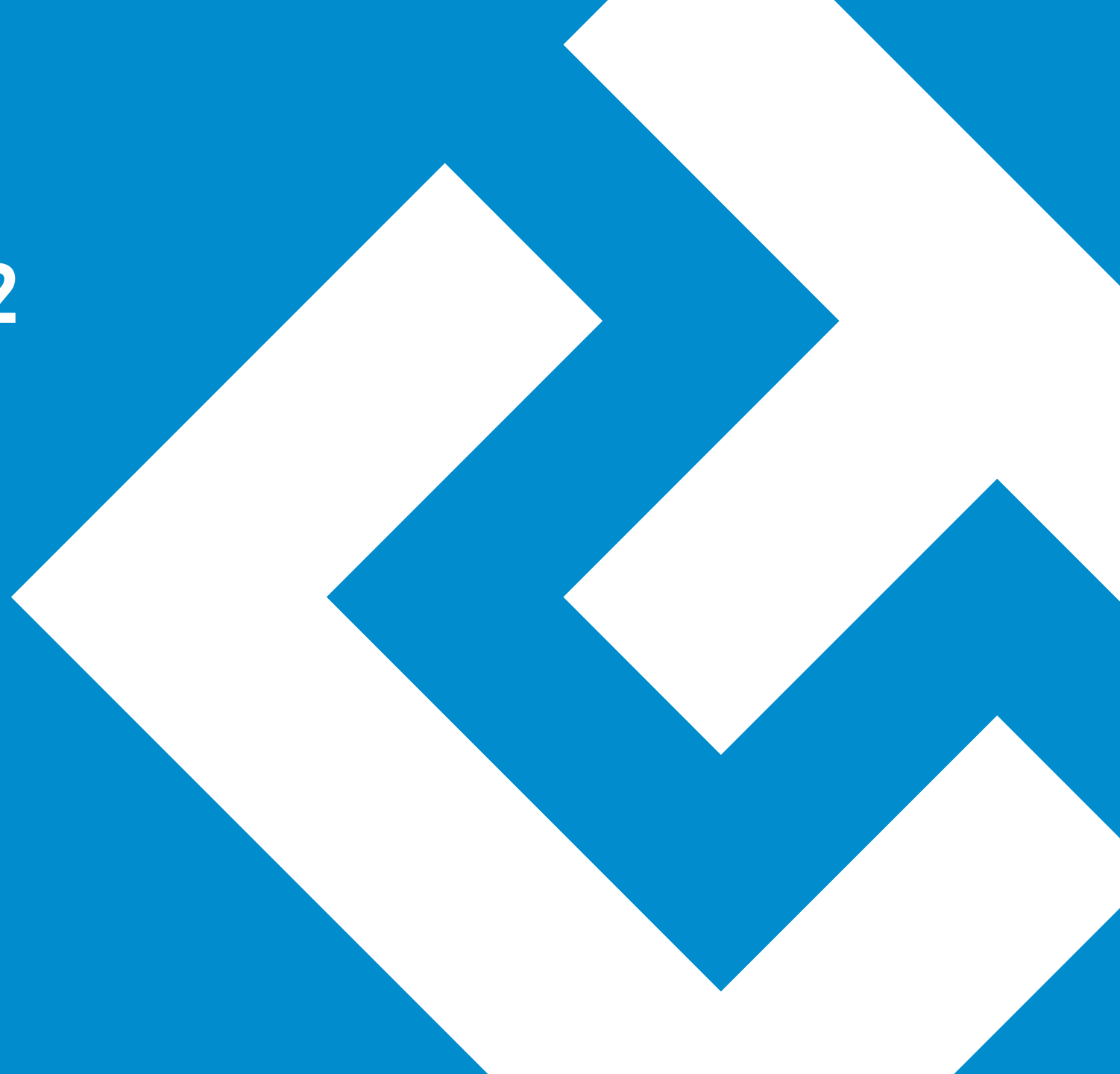

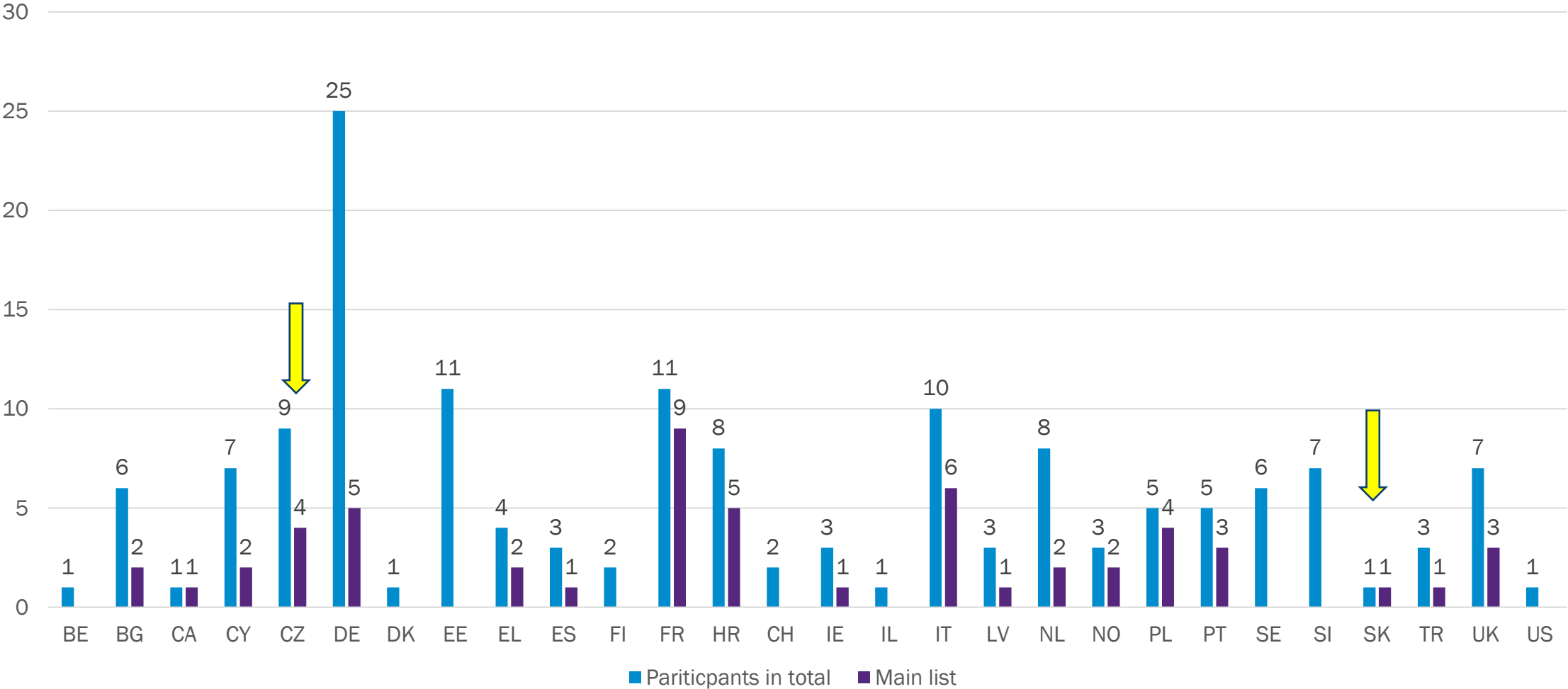

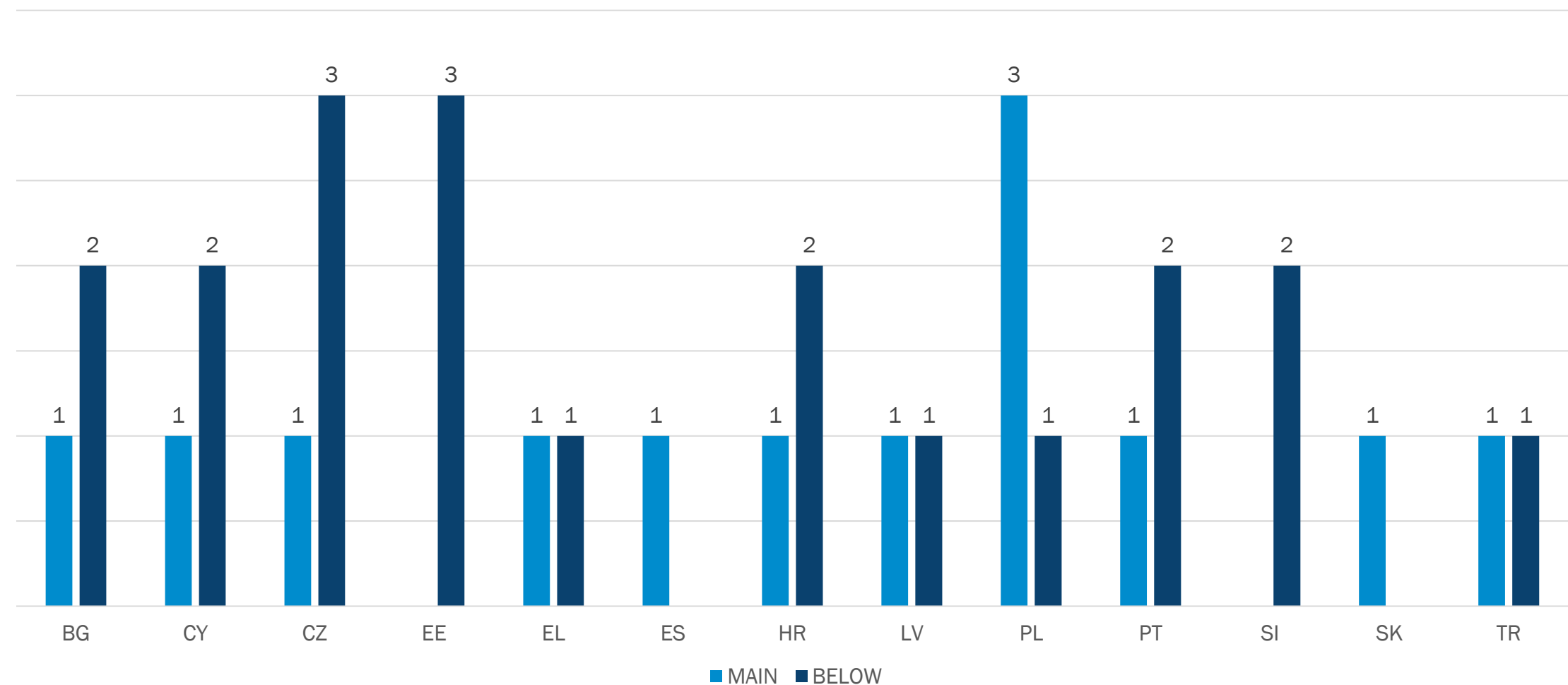

GENERALISED FEEDBACK ON FTOP FOR
SUCCESSFUL PROJECTS



EXCELLENCE (1)

STRATEGIC VISION

- too broadly defined, scope and ambitions too wide-reaching and insufficiently focused
- state-of-the-art not suitably referenced; advancement beyond the state-of-the-art not convincingly demonstrated
- novel and innovative aspects not sufficiently highlighted
- approaches to achieving the stated goals not properly defined

CHALLENGES

- specific challenges for both the research discipline and/or the region not fully discussed
- some proposals address either scientific or operational challenges, but not both

HUMAN RESOURCES

- staff recruitment and retention approaches not appropriately addressed
- lack of concrete and attractive incentives to recruit and retain staff

EXCELLENCE (2)

AUTONOMY

- decision-making mechanisms, distribution of responsibilities, management bodies and independence from existing structure(s) not adequately addressed

SYNERGIES

- existing or potential synergies with EU/national/regional funds and policies not clearly or sufficiently identified
- no adequate description of how projects will work with or add value to policy instruments

OBJECTIVES

- measurability of the objectives often not assured
- no or insufficient number of suitable indicators (KPIs) to verify achievement
- objectives not sufficiently linked to subsequent actions and activities

PARTNERSHIP

- interaction and mutual benefits between coordinator and advanced partner(s) not always appropriately described
- engagement and commitment of the advanced partner(s) not fully demonstrated

IMPACT

REQUIREMENTS, BARRIERS, MITIGATIONS

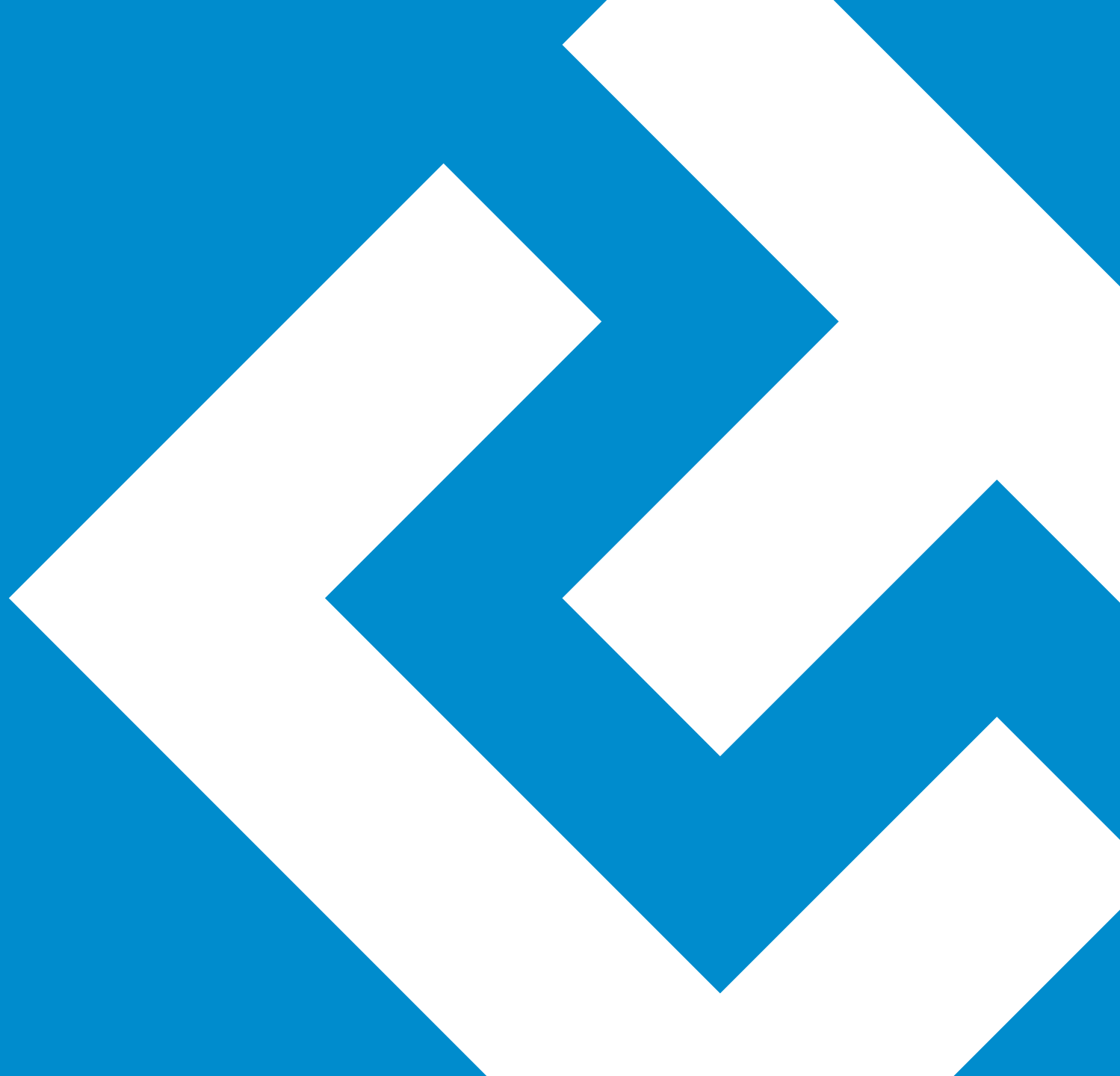
- inadequate analysis of barriers to impact achievement
- lack of well-defined and robust mitigation measures

LONG-TERM SELF-SUSTAINABILITY

- insufficiently convincing plans for long-term sustainability
- insufficient leverage of business opportunities / IP exploitation

EXCELLENCE

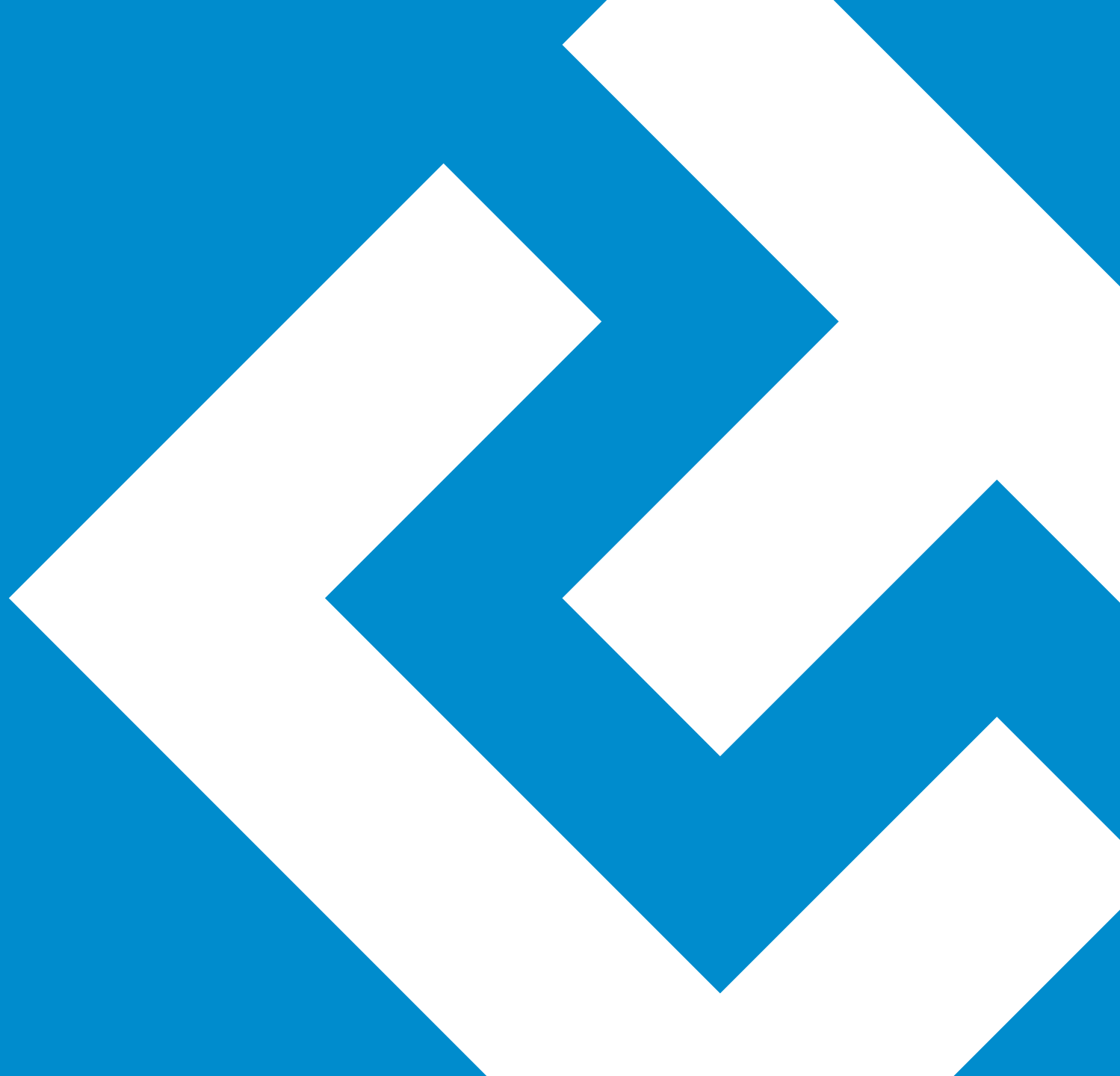
- proposal does not
 - ❖ provide enough detail in its description, making it difficult to assess its real strategic vision and credibility
 - ❖ describe with credible and concrete references how the complementary funding would be obtained
 - ❖ adequately describe how the autonomy of the CoE will be achieved
- way of achieving objectives is not clearly supported by a review of the state of the art
- synergies with national funding and strategies are not described in adequate detail
- human resources and recruitment issues are not adequately addressed
- ambition of the proposal is modest, both in the objective of creating a CoE and in the economic needs and partners

IMPACT

- proposal does not address in sufficient depth or width limited ambition the growth of the CoE activity
- adequate measures of socio-economic outreach are not clearly presented.
- planned impact on the national R&I environment of the host country and local region has not been elaborated in sufficient data
- proposal does not clearly explain the impact at institutional and national level of the results expected from the implementation of the CoE.
- relevant vision concerning long-term sustainability of the Centre of Excellence is not fully described

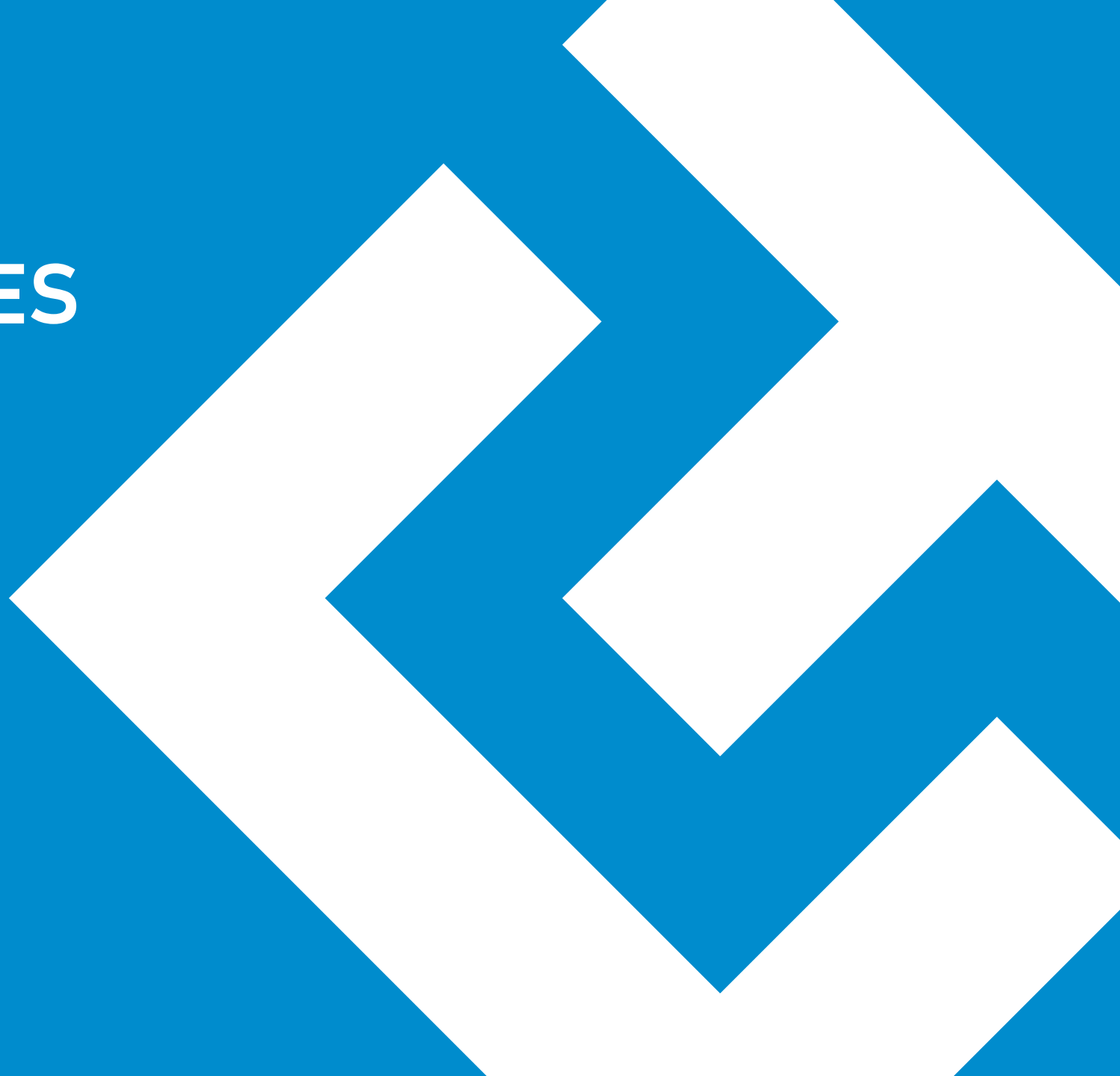
