


Affordable network diodes will be key building-blocks to safely interconnect critical infrastructures (medical, transportation, energy...), according to zero-trust architectures core principles.

European hardware firewall for critical infrastructure interconnection

- SM2G
 Security Mission Information & Innovation Group
- Network diodes enable extraction of data from critical areas without offering a return path to attackers
- Current network diodes are too costly and complex to be generalized
- Full-hardware network diodes with automated white list filtering and deep packet inspection will complement classical but still fragile software-based firewalls
