

Destination 1 - Climate sciences and responses for the transformation towards climate neutrality

- improving knowledge of the Earth system and ability to predict and project its changes under different natural and socio-economic drivers
- better estimation of the impacts of climate change; design and evaluation of solutions and pathways for climate change mitigation and adaptation and related social transformation
- for 2021:
 - 1stage call
 - budget: 136 mil. eur; deadline: 7 September 2021
- 9 topics (7 RIA, 2 CSA):
 - greenhouse gas fluxes & CO₂ removal technologies; modelling the role of circular economy; synergies of EU climate change research; integrated assessment in climate goals; climate change impacts and risks, mitigation and adaptation options; standardising of climate services; economic methods for decision-making on climate; restoration of natural wetlands; forest management



Destination 2 - Cross-sectoral solutions for the climate transition

- distinct cross-cutting thematic areas
- for 2021:
 - 1stage call
 - budget: 231 mil. eur; deadline: 19 October 2021
- 16 topics (11 RIA, 4 CSA, 1 Cofund):
 - Battery value chain (raw materials; generations 3b, 4a, 4b Li-ion batteries; manufacturing technology development; recycling processes,...)
 - Emerging breakthrough technologies and climate solutions (methane cracking; non-CO2 greenhouse gases removal; direct atmospheric carbon capture and conversion,...)
 - Citizens and stakeholder engagement (fostering a just transition in Europe;
 Strengthening Social Sciences and Humanities; accelerating the climate transition in difficult contexts,...)
 - Communities and cities (Co-Funded Partnership: Driving Urban Transitions to a sustainable future)
