




WIDENING COUNTRIES IN HE

- 15 Member States Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czechia, Estonia, Greece, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia and Slovenia.
- 14 countries associated to the HE (as of 1st April 2024) Albania, Armenia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Faroe Islands, Georgia, Kosovo, Moldova, Montenegro, Morocco, North Macedonia, Serbia, Tunisia, Turkey, Ukraine
- 9 EU Outermost regions (as defined in Art. 349 TFEU,) French Guiana, Guadeloupe, Martinique, Mayotte, Réunion, Saint–Martin, The Azores, Madeira, Canary Islands.



MAIN OBJECTIVE – institution building (creation of a new CoE or substantial modernisation of the existing one) with the aim to:

- ✓ help Widening countries to increase their R&I intensity
- ✓ attain a competitive position in the European R&I system and globally
- ✓ stimulate changes on national level





EUROPEAN EXCELLENCE INITIATIVE

MAIN OBJECTIVE – capacity building for strengthening HEIs networks and cooperation with surrounding ecosystems

- ✓ Raise excellence in science and in value creation through deeper and geographically inclusive cooperation in alliances of HEIs, such as European Universities alliances in Erasmus+, with a particular focus on Widening countries
- ✓ Improve global competitiveness and visibility of Europe's HEIs, creating critical mass in key areas such as the green transition and HE mission areas

EUROPEAN EXCELLENCE INITIATIVE HORIZON-WIDERA-2025-01-ACCES-01

- Consortium: coordinator from Widening country and min. 2 partners from other EU Member States or Countries associated to HE
- Cost for R&I activities cannot exceed 20% of the total budget – see point 3 of the activities catalogue:
 - 3. development of research excellence
 - Sharing R&I capacities including infrastructures
 - Developing joint strategic R&I agendas
 - Seed R&I projects to test R&I agendas, explore new joint strands and consolidate partnership
- Educational activities are excluded

EIC PRE-ACCELERATOR - WIDENING HORIZON-WIDERA-2025-02-ACCES-01

- Mono-beneficiary action one legal entity (SME) from a Widening country
- Each proposals evaluated by 3 experts following the evaluation criteria of EIC Transition Open (1st evaluation step)
- Seal of Excellence awarded to all projects meeting the evaluation thresholds but not funded due to lack of available budget
- Successful applicants and those with SoE will have free access to EIC Business Accelerator Services

- ✓ Open up closed networks and overcome barriers

HOP ON FACILITY (HORIZON-WIDERA-2025-03-ACCES-01)

- Additional partner and his tasks or Work Package should be described in a dedicated proposal template (available on the call page)
- Choose only from the list of eligible RIA projects available on <u>FTOP</u>
- Proposal must be submitted by a coordinator of the relevant project
- No more than 10% of the proposed budget can be allocated to the coordinator for integration of a new Widening beneficiary

- ✓ Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Georgia, Kosovo, Moldova, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Serbia, Türkiye, and Ukraine



SUPPORT TO ENLARGEMENT COUNTRIES HORIZON-WIDERA-2025-04-ACCES-01

- Coordinator must be from a Widening country + min. two partners from other EU MS or AC
- At least 50% of the budget must be allocated to Widening beneficiaries
- Provide support to
 - national and regional R&I and education initiatives
 - development and implementation of Smart Specialisation Strategies and macro-regional strategies
- FSTP may be provided in form of grants of max.
 amount 60 000 EUR

WIDENING REGIONAL INNOVATION VALLEYS





MAIN OBJECTIVE – to foster the creation of efficient, open, inclusive and interconnected European innovation ecosystems in line with the New European Innovation Agenda

- ✓ Consortium of at least 3 national or regional authorities
- √ CO-FUND action (50% : 50%)
- ✓ Either Financial support to third parties (FSTP), PCP or PPI is obligatory

IMPLEMENTING CO-FUNDED ACTION PLANS FOR CONNECTED RIVS IN WIDENING COUNTRIES (WC) HORIZON-WIDERA-2025-05-ACCESS-01

- Mirroring the call HORIZON-EIE-2025-02-CONNECT-02 in the EIE WP 2025 adapted to WC
- Coordinator from a WC and at least 2 national or regional authorities from 2 other different MS or AC, out of which 1 must be from WC and 1 from non-WC
- FSTP max. grant 0,6 M€
- Letters of commitment for the sources of cofunding must be attached
- First annual work plan has to be part of the proposal



- ✓ transfer of knowledge and skills and exchange of best practices
- ✓ raising the research profile of the institution and its staff
- ✓ special focus on strengthening research management and administrative skills

ERA FELLOWSHIPS 2026 and 2027

HOP ON FACILITY 2026

MAIN OBJECTIVE – individual grants for post-docs implemented in Widening countries

- ✓ applications are submitted to MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships calls
- ✓ automatically transferred ERA Fellowships in case not receiving the MSCA grant
- √ calls opened every year

MAIN OBJECTIVE – accession of one new additional partner from a Widening country to already implemented RIA project funded from

- ✓ Any of the six Clusters of HE Pillar 2
- ✓ EIC Pathfinder instrument
- ✓ Call not planned for 2027



RESEARCH MANAGEMENT FACILITY 2026

MAIN OBJECTIVE – address research management and its multiple dimensions

- Provide training and consulting services to institutions in Widening countries that
 - Lack such capacities
 - Do not have sufficient expertise for
 - ✓ Setting up a grant office
 - ✓ And / or research management teams
 - To empower them to take over the consortium leadership tasks
 - FSTP may be provided (grants up to 60 000 EUR)

MAIN OBJECTIVE – increase the innovation potential of early-stage deeptech startups in the Widening countries, in order to:

- ✓ enable them to better attract private investments and scale up


