Promoting independent living and social inclusion for people with severe psychiatric conditions and with severe traumatic brain injury.

La Bonne Semence is a non-profit social cooperative based in Northern Italy, committed to the rehabilitation and independent living of people affected by severe psychiatric conditions. Since 1996 we have supported individuals transitioning from institutional care — including former residents of judicial psychiatric hospitals (OPG) — to community-based living through personalised support, housing solutions and rehabilitation programmes.

Our model combines clinical expertise (psychiatric, psychological, and neurological evaluations) with a strong focus on empowerment and social reintegration. We manage several day-care centers and protected apartments across the Lombardy region and offer structured pathways for personal development, social participation, and, when possible, reintegration into the workforce.

Key areas of impact:

- Independent living pathways with health monitoring
- Rehabilitation and therapeutic support
- Cultural, educational and social inclusion activities
- Ongoing support and training for families and caregivers
