The University of Valladolid - Department of Sociology and Social Work is interested in joining a consortium focused on coordinated neighbourhood-based responses to homelessness and severe social exclusion. Our interest lies in how local social services, housing services, health and mental health services, employment support, third-sector organisations and community resources can be better coordinated to improve access, continuity of care, social inclusion and psychosocial wellbeing among people experiencing homelessness.

	<p>From a Social Work and Social Services perspective, we can contribute by analysing the functioning of local social service systems, identifying barriers to access and coordination, and evaluating how integrated neighbourhood-based social infrastructure can support more effective and humane responses to homelessness.</p> <p>A specific added value of our Department would be the analysis of frontline professionals' experiences, including emotional burden, ethical dilemmas, moral distress, burnout and perceived lack of resources when working with homelessness and social vulnerability. This professional perspective could complement the analysis of service users' experiences and contribute to the design of more sustainable and coordinated intervention models.</p> <p>The project could include a Spanish case study in collaboration with municipal social services, third-sector organisations and community-based services, contributing comparative evidence on social services coordination, professional wellbeing, user experience, access to services and community integration.</p>
